God keeps blessing. Now, I had to keep that in mind over the next two weeks. I had been invited to speak at a missions conference in Kansas City on Thursday and Friday. My return flight was scheduled for me to get back to San Francisco by Saturday night. Unfortunately, my flight was cancelled...twice!! So I missed church that week. And to make matters worse, I got COVID. So that meant I missed the next week as well.

But something incredible happened...the church went on without me. Isn't that AWESOME! The people all took on their rolls and kept going. It is a glorious thing as a Pastor to realize that the church doesn't need you to exist.

It's glorious because it is humbling. God doesn't have to use us. He just doesn't. He doesn't need our skills, our time, our abilities...none of it. God is fully capable of fulfilling the mission all by himself. And yet, the amazingly wonderful thing is that He CHOOSES to use us! And that should be enough to bring us all to our knees in humble adoration of a God that loves us enough not only to save us, but also to use us to bring others to Him.
